

Annual Reporting Measures for CAEP Standards

Indicators of Teaching Effectiveness

The Principles of Learning and Teaching Praxis tests are required to assess a new teacher’s general pedagogical knowledge. The tests are designed to reflect the Interstate Teacher Assessment and Support Consortium (InTASC) Model Core Teaching Standards. The pass rate for completers in the Elementary Education program was 100% during the most recent years of reporting (2016 – 2019).

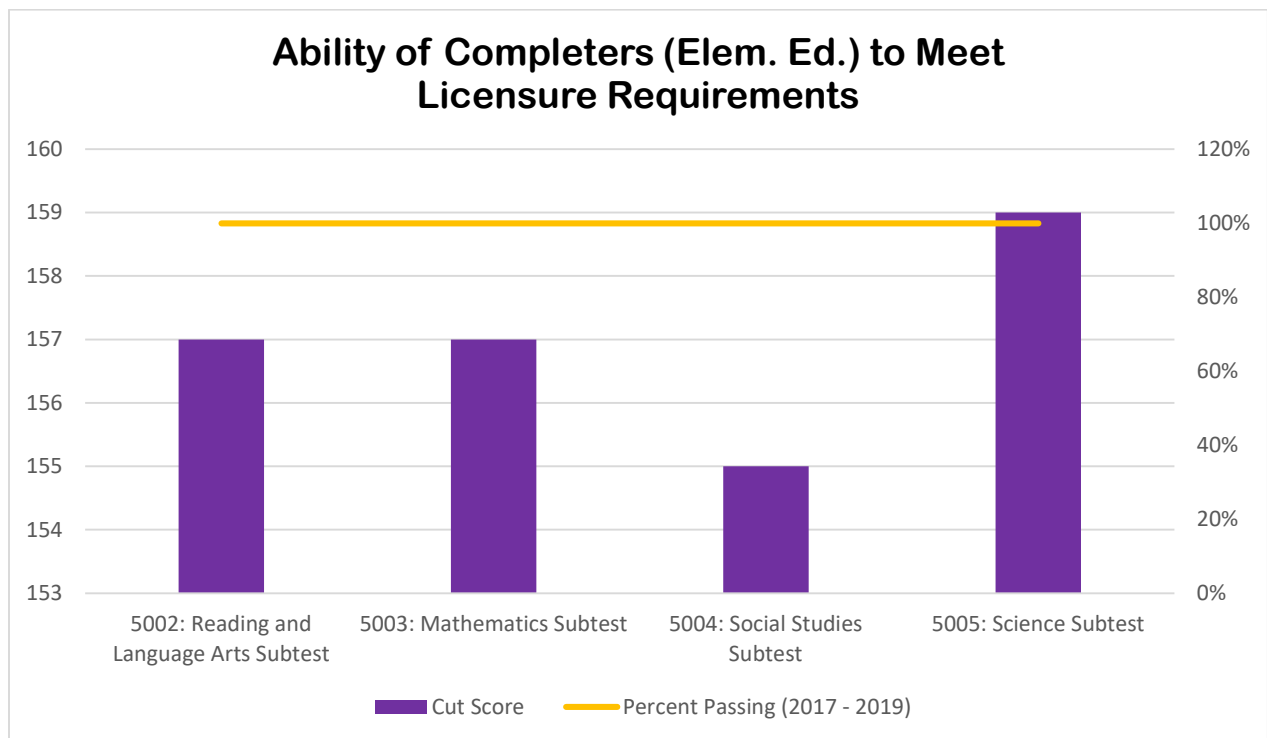
Graduation Rates

Ability of Completers to Meet Licensure Requirements

For initial licensure in South Carolina, all candidates must 1) meet degree and licensure requirements for their licensure area, 2) pass the Principles of Learning and Teaching (PLT) test for their area, and 3) pass the appropriate Praxis Subject Assessments required for their licensure area. Completers must also submit the appropriate licensure form and fees. To apply for certification in Elementary Education, the completer must pass the Elementary Education: Multiple Subjects test. And, with the aim of passing the Elementary Education: Multiple Subjects test, completers must receive a passing score on each subtest. The chart below demonstrates that 100% of completers during the 2017 – 2018 and 2018 – 2019 years were able to pass their Praxis Elementary Education: Multiple Subjects exams (the graph shows the cut score for each subtest and the percent of completers who passed).



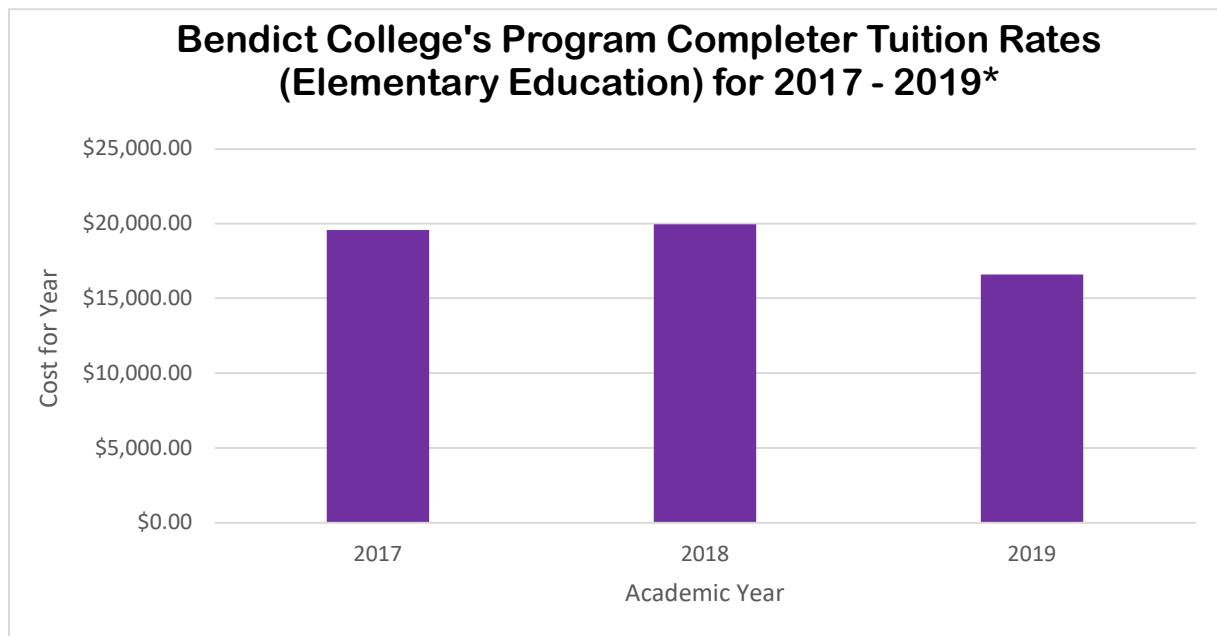
Ability of Completers to be Hired in Education Positions
