- Degree Seeking Admission An applicant who wishes to obtain a degree should choose this

For applicants who do not hold a business degree, documentation regarding competencies in the following areas are required: accounting, finance, management, marketing, macroeconomics, and statistics. Competencies can be demonstrated through:

- Transcript of the courses below, the course equivalent, or a higher level course in the subject area (Grade of C or better required) or
- Completion of relevant Peregrine Academic Leveling Courses (70% score or better required)
 - NOTE: Students are responsible for the costs of coursework required to demonstrate competencies.
